











## Q1. How familiar are you with the City's Operating Budget?







# Q2. City Council is attempting to minimize any property tax increase for 2018. What annual tax increase would you support?




## Q3. If you chose a tax increase in Question 2, where would you suggest the increase be spent? (Check as many as applicable)




### Q4. If you chose zero tax increase in Question 2, where would you suggest service reductions be made? (Check as many as applicable)




